

Hello, Dr Makis.

I'm a long-time subscriber and appreciate the work you are doing. I've had a BCC since around Feb/March of 2024, noted by my GP in June, and I've been waiting for a dermatologist appointment since then (scheduled for mid-Nov).

After reading your emails with testimonials about Fenben and Ivm, I took matters into my own hands and started treating it with Fenben I got from Amazon. (Safeguard Paste 10%).

I've been applying a dab of the paste twice a day since Sept 25. The results were not immediate but it's picked up steam in the last 10 days or so, to the point where the scab is almost gone, leaving only some scar tissue. At first I tried covering it with a bandaid but the paste would harden somewhat, then pull the scab off with it when removing the bandaid. I'm booked for early Feb to have it removed. It took a couple of weeks for the scab to fall off after the biopsy, and this is how it looks now:

Maybe it's deep into the tissue despite having improved the surface cells. No idea.
