- 53 year old Canadian Cancer patient diagnosed with Stage 4 Cholangiocarcinoma, metastatic to liver in March 2023.
- Patient had chemo and reached out to me in October 2023.

Good Evening Doctor Makis,

I have been following your work online for some time.

In March I diagnosed with the devastating news that I have stage 4 Liver and Bile Duct cancer.

The rare cholangiocarcinoma.

After initially being diagnosed, the oncologist recommended we participate in the [REDACTED] Program. Which I'm not sure was the best use of our money, as they were unable to provide any results.

Doctor at that time I'm hospital gave me 12/16 to live and to get my affairs in order.

My tumour is 10cm and a PETSCAN that I was denied for here in Canada, so I went to the States and paid \$3,400 out of pocket showed the runout was just confined to my liver, no other organs.

My oncologist didn't think I would make it through one cycle of chemotherapy. Tomorrow will be the dose of my third round.

No side effects, drove myself back and forth, high energy level, and great appetite

But none of that seems to matter to my oncologist.

I was taken off the bag of immunotherapy because the tumour didn't shrink, but also really didn't grow except a super tiny spot that the radiologist couldn't radiate on me because he didn't want to harm what's left of my healthy liver.

Friday, a second oncologist at [REDACTED] (which I went for a second option I) was worse than the oncologist I have now.

He told me my supposed mortality chart, and to watch for "the end" because I'd be lucky to make it to summer.

It's all been confusing except for one thing...I REFUSE to let these doctors put a time line on me. They are not GOD and everybody is different.

I'm a 53 year otherwise healthy female, who continues to work.

Please, how can we connect and look at options. I'm not going to Mexico. Lol

Don't lose hope,

I have articles on Ivermectin, Fenbendazole and Melatonin on my substack.

The Ivermectin is 1mg/kg or 2mg/kg daily

Fenbendazole is typically 444mg daily

Melatonin is anywhere from 100mg-300mg daily

These are all high dose protocols that people are using for Stage 4 cancers. I can't give you medical advice or recommend specific protocols but these are the doses some people are using

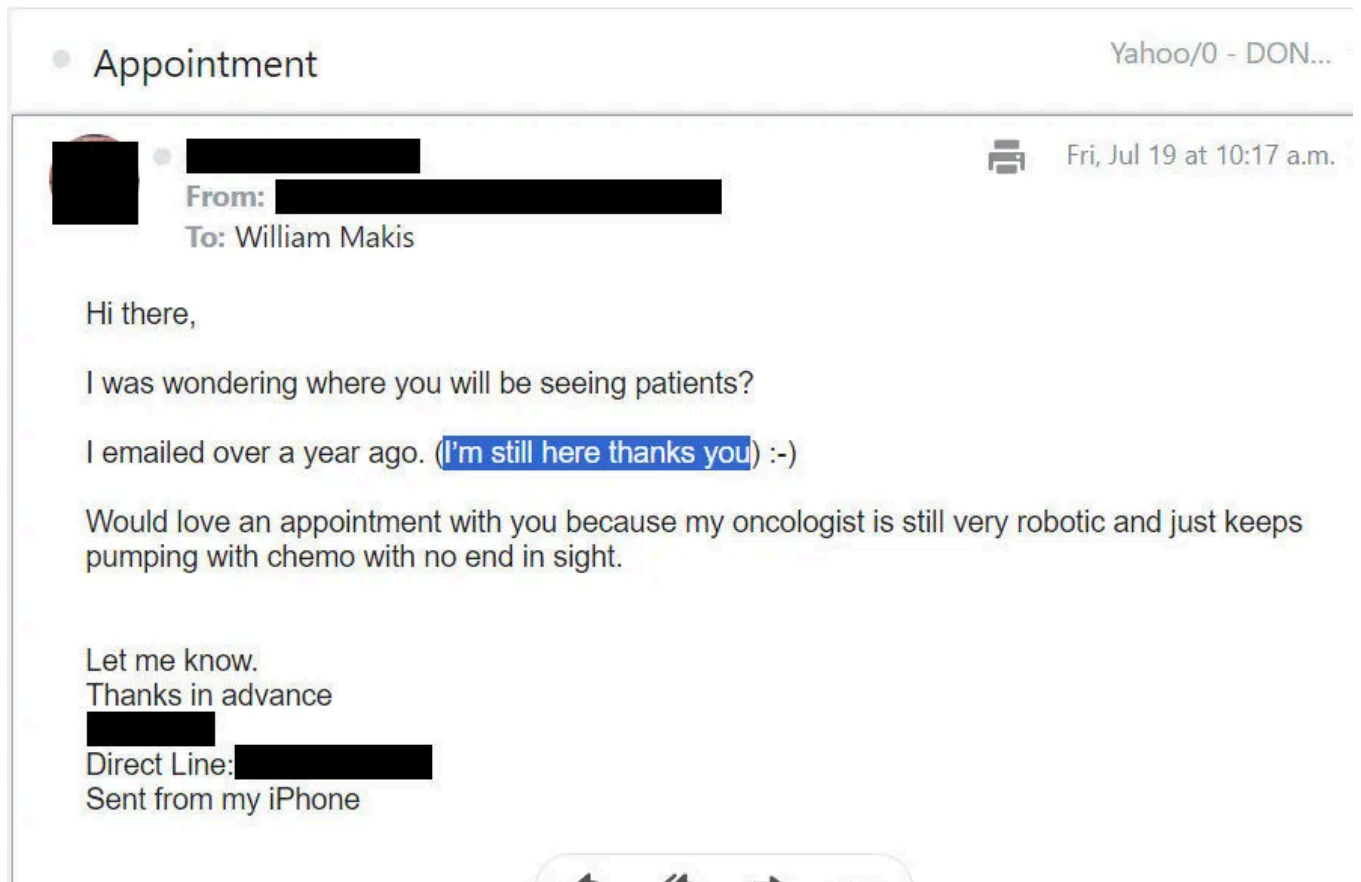

## The Treatment:

- Patient was diagnosed in March 2023
- she had several liver lesions, largest measured up to 15cm.
- She had 15 rounds of cisplatin and 5 rounds of FOLFOX.
- In November 2023, she started Fenbendazole 444mg (Panacur) and Melatonin 100mg
- In August 2024 we added 150mg of Ivermectin or 2.5m/kg/day, and CBD-TH Oil.

## My Take...

Patient had two Canadian Oncologists, neither of whom thought she was going to make it.

Oct.2023: "Second Oncologist...told me...to watch for "the end" because I'd be lucky to make it to summer (2024)."

Well, they were wrong.

I can't tell you how happy this story makes me.

I love what I do. And this is why I fight.
