Dear Dr Makis

I have just been watching the video with Mike Adams and yourself re your cancer coaching. Firstly let me just say that the world should be thankful for good people like yourself who are not afraid to speak out and speak the truth. I know you must be receiving so many messages from people asking for your help but I sincerely hope that you can please find the time to help me with some information about the recommended cancer protocol?

I am a seventy year old woman - lost my right leg 2 yrs ago with spindle cell sarcoma. Was cancer free til last Nov. when the cancer metastised to my right lung. Have had palliative chemo and at the same time followed the Joe Tippens protocol ie 225 grams fenben once every day, 12 mg Ivermectin for 3 days on and 4 days off. Plus CBD, vit E, milk thistle, and curcumin. I also have been taking VIT D with K and Vit C with zinc for many years now. Had scan after chemo in Aug and had very good unexpected results - shrinkage of tumour by over 60% and disappearance of multiple other lesions. So have been off chemo for nearly 4 months. Still taking fenben etc and had scan 3 weeks ago which showed tumour had increased very slightly in size. Not had full report yet. Oncologist showed me on screen.

So although I've had some positive results, I don't know whether the fenben protocol was what did it and if it did, the improvement seems to have stopped. So is this usual and am I taking the right dose? Maybe I need to take more? Can you help please? I just can't find the info I need anywhere.

Thank you in advance and I would be so grateful if you can guide me on this.

- took the following:
- Palliative chemo (not expected to help)
- 222mg Fenbendazole 3 days on / 4 days off (Joe Tippens Protocol)
- 12mg Ivermectin 3 days on / 4 days off
- Unexpected Results: tumor shrinkage by 60% & disappearance of multiple lesions (!!)

My Take...

Spindle Cell Sarcoma is a cancer that's notoriously difficult to treat.

The response rate of chemo is on the order of 20% (which means 80% of patients don't see ANY improvement)

The response rate to chemotherapy for soft tissue sarcoma, including spindle cell sarcoma, varies by study and treatment: [🔗](#)

- **Doxorubicin:** The response rate for doxorubicin monotherapy is around 20%. [🔗](#)
- **Doxorubicin and ifosfamide:** The objective response rate for doxorubicin and ifosfamide is around 20–30%. [🔗](#)
- **Doxorubicin and trabectedin:** When combined, doxorubicin and trabectedin can shrink tumors enough to allow for surgical removal in 20% of patients. [🔗](#)
- **Talimogene laherparepvec and pembrolizumab:** In a phase 2 trial, the best overall objective response rate was 35%. [🔗](#)

To get tumor shrinkage by 60% and disappearance of multiple lesions is stunning. The chemo was palliative and was not expected to help in this case.

And these were very low doses of Ivermectin & Fenbendazole.

I tend to suggest higher doses as cancer killing with Ivermectin & Fenbendazole is dose dependent.
