STORY:

- 61 year old Texas woman was diagnosed with Stage 4 NSCLC Lung Cancer in December 2024.
- She had a 2.6cm Left lower lung mass, lymph nodes and three metastases in the pelvis.
- She had started low dose Ivermectin (12mg) and Fenben (444mg) on Dec.1, 2024.
- We started in late January 2025:
- Ivermectin 1mg/kg/day

- Fenbendazole 888mg/day
- Follow-up CT was done April 9, 2025

Hi Dr Makis,

First of all, I wanted to thank you for all you do for the many people in my situation!

I wanted to give you an update on my progress. I had a CT Scan on 4/9 which showed a 40% reduction in my lower left lung lobe from 1.8x1.3cm compared to 2.8 x 2.1cm. Also, I had a decrease of supraclavicular nodes(4mm compared to 7mm) and subcarinal nodes (5mm compared to 8mm). Stable right mid diaphragmatic node. It was 6 weeks since I have been on the targeted drug and 8 weeks on your protocol. Overall feeling much better! I do have a question regarding liver enzymes. My ALT has been on the higher end [REDACTED]. It started around [REDACTED] in Feb. My doctor had me stop the targeted drug until my liver enzymes go down. It's been 2 weeks with no decrease, so they had me take prednisone for a week. I will go back for blood tests this week.

My Take...

- Primary lung tumor shrunk 2.8x2.1cm to 1.8x1.3cm = 75% volume shrinkage
- Supraclavicular nodes 7mm to 4mm = 81% volume shrinkage
- Subcarinal nodes 8mm to 5mm = 76% volume shrinkage

These are spectacular results for Lung Cancer after only 2.5 months!

This result was achieved with a combination of Ivermectin + Fenbendazole + Targeted Therapy.

I've had quite a bit of success with Stage 4 Lung Cancer.

I usually start Fenbendazole at 1000mg a day. It's very well tolerated and it seems to be a dose that sees a lot of success.

Stanford University group that published 3 Fenbendazole Cancer Cures (2021 Chiang et al) also used 1000mg Fenbendazole/day with no side effects.



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
