
IVERMECTIN and FENBENDAZOLE Testimonial - 63 year old woman in Philippines with Stage 4 Pancreatic Cancer sees 80% tumor shrinkage after 1 month!

Hello Dr. Makis,

I am desperate to give help to my mother (63 years old) whose pancreatic adenocarcinoma recently progressed to Stage 4 (liver mets).

She was placed under mFolfirinox. The cancer reduced in size and has slowed down and was scheduled for surgery. However, her surgeon rescheduled her to another month. When we did a re-scan, it had jumped to her liver and delayed surgery. They placed her under mFolfirinox again but the cancer has slightly progressed.

They are now placing her under gemcitabine and radiation to control her cancer.

Can you give me any advise about Ivermectin + Fenbendazole treatment for her? She is a strong woman and is trying her best to fight cancer for me and my father.

STORY:

- 63 year old woman in the Philippines had recently progressed to Stage 4
 Pancreatic Cancer with liver metastases.
- We started in mid February 2025:
- Ivermectin 1.5mg/kg/day
- Fenbendazole 1500mg/day

RESULTS:

Dear Dr. William Makis,

I hope all is well with you. We have been seeing you fight back the system and we're always going to support you and your cause!

We have an exciting update!

My mother recently got an ultrasound scan to see any bile obstruction (there was none) but here's a HUGE improvement on her pancreatic tumor size:

January 27 2025: 5.3 x 5.4 x 5.5 cm and CEA is 35.16 ng/ml

February 10: Started gemcitibine + paclitaxel

February 24 2025: Started Dr. Makis' protocol

March 28 2025: 3.6 x 3.1 x 2.7 cm and CEA is 106.97 ng/ml

We're so excited by the reduction in the tumor size! Nothing short of a miracle! But the CEA seems to have increased which we are confused about? Why is this so?

Also, our Oncologist (she doesn't know about our protocol) is thinking about whether to give my mother her 3rd chemo cycle since her bilirubin is slightly going up. We want her to continue the protocol with the 3rd chemo cycle. Is there any advice you can give us so we can slightly address the bilirubin?

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Hello Dr. William Makis,

Thank you so much for taking the time to reply this fast to our questions. I would imagine the amount of work you're doing and the sheer volume of attacks and stress you're going through. This is why all of us are really appreciative of your effort towards us, your cancer patients.

Yes Dr. Makis, we'll schedule a CEA test next week.

My mother is taking the following doses as per the protocol:

- 1. Ivermectin (Iverheal-12 Brand): 96 mg (1.5mg/kg of bodyweight, she is 59 kgs right now)
- 2. Fenbendazole (Fenben Pro brand): 1554 mg

We have not included CBD oil unfortunately since it is considered a heavily regulated substance in the Philippines. My mother is also taking UDCA and Transmetil for liver support. Her latest labs are stellar, especially the Liver function tests (From 100's down to 50's) and her total Bilirubins are now back to normal.

We would do any advice you would give us ASAP, if there is any.

neads was to update you about the good news:

CEA Tests

- 1. January 2025 36
- 2. March 2025 107
- 3. April 2025 32.77

Just wanted to share this success we experienced before the PET scan in 3 weeks. Godbless you always Dr. William Makis!! Attaching a PDF for reference.

My Take....

- Only one month on high dose Ivermectin (1.5mg/kg) and Fenbendazole 1554mg
- Pancreatic mass shrunk from 5.3x5.4x5.5cm to 3.6x3.1x2.7cm = 81% TUMOR VOLUME SHRINKAGE.
- Fascinatingly, CEA went from 36 to 107 to 32.8 during this time.
- Possible explanation: rapid cancer cell killing caused CEA to rise temporarily
- The rapid cancer cell killing was due to chemo + Ivermectin + Fenbendazole
