Please note the following:

It is a stage 4 lung cancer diagnosis (please see full docs attached for more info and sorry some are still in [REDACTED], please disregard if too complicated), that has spread into the bones, liver and adrenal gland. I've had PET scans (was living in [REDACTED] June, hence the docs in [REDACTED]) and also recently (last 2 weeks, as now back in UK), had a Chest CT and 2nd biopsy taken that confirms the same again.

They will prescribe coming Monday 12 August for me to be on Osimertinib (Tagrisso) tablets, I believe to be checked after 9 - 12 weeks to see if working?

I have never had any COVID 19 Vaccines.

Weight is 63kg, height 167cm.

I'm taking Omega 3, Vit D / K3, bicarb of soda water morning and evening. Considered wormwood but wanted to find out more from you first please.

Hope this helps and really hope you can help me further!

I'm on week 2 of my protocol which is 8 x 12mg ivermectin per day (at once) and 222mg x 2 fenbendazole a day (split up) and feel ok apart from I have had the affected vision every day since about day 3 (I'm on day 8 now) and can't see objects well as light and dark and blurred - should this be so or should it have lessened by now? Being in the light outside is ok but in darker rooms I have trouble with vision.

I know you mentioned this for a couple of days but as this is longer, thought should mention as feels weird.

I wanted to share some good news with you after receiving my 1st scan results back from the oncology

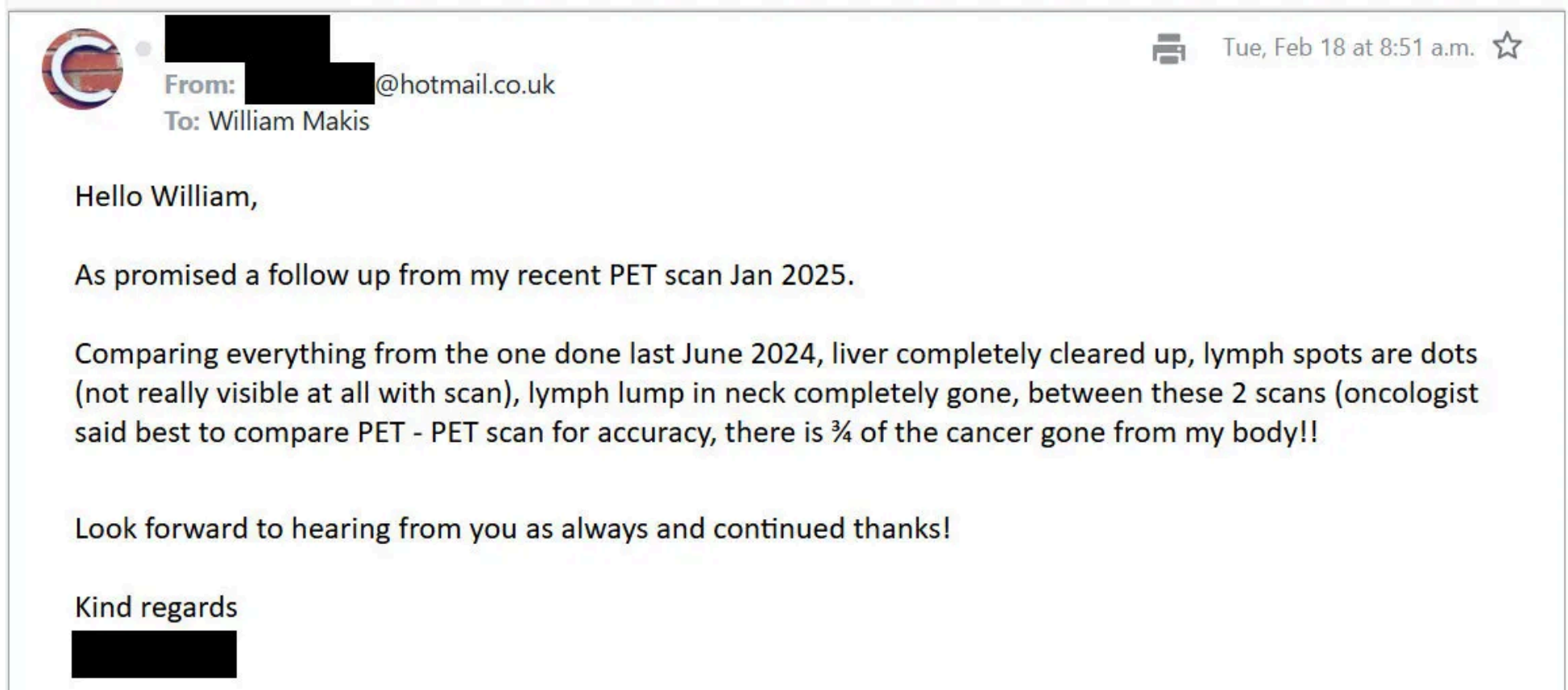
team (after 3 rounds of 28 days of Tagrisso tabs).

They are good! The cancer is stable and all lesions / tumours have shrunk. The biggest shrink of all was the one above adrenal gland which has gone from (oncologist here couldn't say exactly but thinks around just over) 6 - 3.6cm! The spots on the left lung and liver were "so small they were too small to measure, maybe a mm or so."

I am happy to continue to take my alternative treatment of course :)

My Take...

45 year old UK woman with Stage 4 NSCLC Lung Cancer with lymph node, liver, and adrenal metastases.

In early September 2024 we started:

Ivermectin 1 to 2 mg/kg/day (eventually built up to 96mg Ivermectin a day, or 1.5mg/kg)

Fenbendazole 444mg a day

CBD Oil 25mg/day

Melatonin 120mg/day

RESULTS:

Adrenal metastasis shrunk from 6cm to 3.6cm

Lymph node metastases resolved

Liver metastases resolved

Oncologist estimated 75% of tumor burden had resolved.

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
