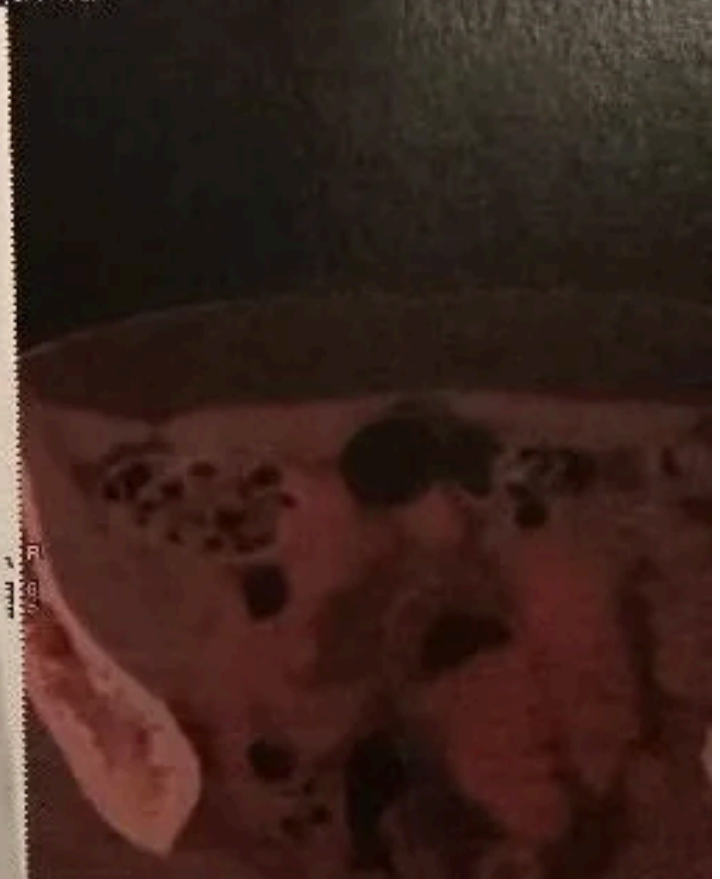
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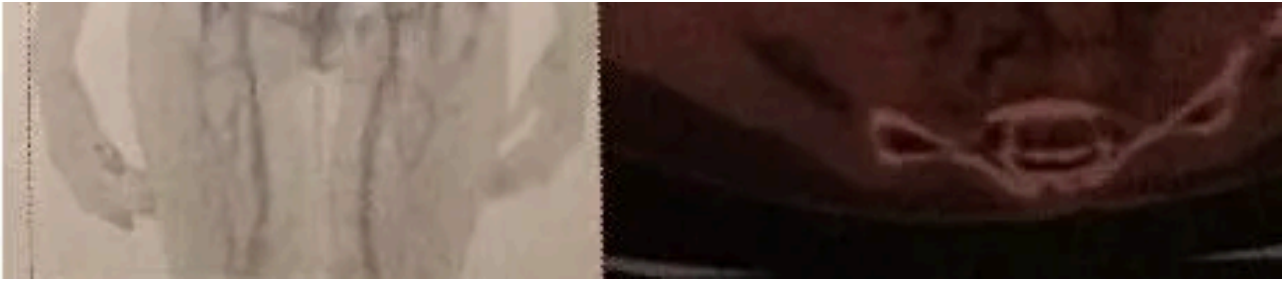

(Richter syndrome on type B large cell lymphoma)

Here are the photos from September and today.

This after only two R Chop cures and perfect hematological tolerance

She has been on ivermectin 1 mg/kg and mebendazole (200 mg per day) since May.

We did not stop the treatment during chemotherapy of course, despite the oncologist's refusal to take nothing other than chemotherapy.

I wonder if we will need to do other R CHOP consolidation cycles or will we be able to afford to monitor while continuing ivermectin and mebendazole?

In any case it seems certain that this protocol helped her a lot to obtain this result. What do you think?
