
IVERMECTIN is better than any allergy pill as it is long acting - Testimonial from a Canadian nurse who grew up with Ivermectin on a farm


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my ivermectin story

Dear Dr. Makis,

This letter to thank you for all the information on ivermectin is long overdue.

I grew up on a grain and cattle farm. Ivermectin liquid pour-on has been used to treat cattle for over fourty years. I was the one in the family that always used the applicator to apply the ivermectin onto the midline backs of the cows. There is not a farm/ranch/feedlot in Canada where someone got accidently sprayed with the liquid, the applicator broke and needed to be fixed in the middle of the cow pen. (I have done this many times.) I am also a Registered Nurse. Looking back, if Ivermectin was such a bad drug, why did we not learn about this in nurses training? (I graduated as an RN in very small town Health Centre and hospitals everywhere across the country should have had the antidote in stock to give to those that had "accidental exposure." There is not an "antidote" because none is needed.

I first heard about Ivermectin for covid treatment from Theo Fleury. Then, I came across your information on Twitter, now X. I am now a subscriber to your substack. I have learned so much from you!

I have had "allergies" all my life. I was diagnosed with celiac disease as an adult in 2002. I had many symptoms over the years til diagnosis. I had a chronic non-productive cough (fibrosing alveolitis of the lung), from gluten, which the doctors did not know how to treat, they thought it was a "type of asthma". I was prescribed Ventolin – which did not help at all. Flo-Nase and Mometasone helped reduce some of the nasal, upper airway symptoms. I also took several OTC antihistamines - Reactine, Benadryl, and Aerius. These drugs helped eliminate allergy symptoms, but I knew within minutes of the drug wearing off, as the symptoms all returned (nasal congestion, cough.) About a year after I started to eat gluten free, I realized I did not have the chronic cough I used to have. I used to cough until I retched.

I assist my brother to farm helping feed cattle, the dust from the oats and barley grain and the wheat, oats and barley straw would cause coughing, sneezing. I also help to haul grain (barley and wheat) during harvest season. One exposure to this dust would make me sick for several days if I did not pre-medicate myself or double dose on Aerius and take the Mometasone several times a day.

After reading your articles on Ivermectin helping treat covid respiratory symptoms, I thought maybe it will help for the allergy/celiac symptoms too. The autumn of 2023, I took - 1 Aerius tablet per day, and 1-12 mg tablet of Ivermectin a day. I gradually quit the Aerius and went with the Ivermectin only, and did not get sick at all! I continued with the Ivermectin for the spring and harvest season of 2024. I took 2-12 mg of Ivermectin a few days at the start of harvest this year when I was exposed to a lot of dust when unloading loads of wheat and barley at the bins. I wore a mask, but grain dust gets through any mask! I took 1-12 mg Ivermectin daily through harvest, did not need to use the Mometasone at all. The Ivermectin is better than any allergy pill, as it is long acting.

I know that Ivermectin has helped me immensely! This is by no means a proper study, but I know Ivermectin WORKS! I wanted to let you know of my success story, and thank you again for all the information you share.
